Grading

Student's final grades will be based on a relative scale depending on the overall quality of the classes lab work. Percentage will be calculated as follows:

Lab Reports	70%	(9 Laboratory Exercises and 1 Mini-Research Paper)

Quizzes

These will be given at the beginning of (almost) every lab. Roughly five questions mostly covering the material from the previous and current laboratory experiment (this means you should read the lab *before* coming to class).

Graded quizzes may be corrected and returned on the following week for up to half its original credit.

Lab Reports

These are due at the beginning of class one week after completing the experiment. Late labs are a pain for you and me so to discourage this I will take off 20% for each week your lab is late, i.e.

One class late = -20%: Two classes late = -40%: etc.

Missed Quizzes and Labs

Students will only be able to make up these if there is a sufficient reason for them not being able to attend class ("I partied too hard Thursday night" is not sufficient). If you know you have to miss a lab tell me as soon as possible so that we can work out another time for you to makeup the quiz and lab.
