Textbook Chapters

Chapters 21-32 (electromagnetism), 33-34 (geometrical optics). There may be adjustments made, to be announced as the course develops.

Homework Problems

Homework problems will be assigned weekly and collected. Selected problems will be graded. The odd numbered problems have answers in the back of the book. The even numbered problems are of similar quality and do not have answers in the back of the book. Homework is worth 10% of the final grade.
